Town Board Regular Meeting – 6:00PM

Water District No. 7 Public Hearing – 6:15PM

This meeting and public hearing has been recorded and posted on Town of Cape Vincent’s website, as approved by Resolution #25.

Present: Supervisor Christine Stark, Councilman Dan Wiley, Councilman Bill Gould, Councilman Ron Jacobs, Councilwoman Mary Farrell, Highway Superintendent Bill Pond, Water Superintendent Keith Brass, and 45 visitors.

Supervisor Stark opened the meeting at 6:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Privilege of the Floor Regular Meeting items – None

Councilman Gould made a motion to accept the minutes of the January 15, 2026 meeting, seconded by Councilwoman Farrell. No Discussion. All members voted AYE.

Councilwoman Farrell made a motion to accept the Supervisor’s Monthly Financial Report seconded by Councilman Gould. Supervisor Stark voted AYE, Councilwoman Farrell voted AYE, Councilman Jacobs voted AYE, Councilman Gould voted AYE, Councilman Wiley ABSTAINED.

Highway Superintendent Report – Bill reported highway department has been busy plowing and sanding. Bill attended meeting where it was announced bridge on 12E in Three Mile Bay will be closed May to October for repair, so traffic will use the detour route.

Water Superintendent Report – Keith reported town has helped repair water main breaks happening in the village.

Recreation Park Report – Keith reported regular meetings have been held at Rec Park.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Cape Vincent hereby authorize the Board to record Town Board Regular Meetings, Town Board Special Meetings, and Town Board Public Hearings, and place them on the Town’s Website using YouTube as the platform.
